How our volunteers can help you

All our volunteers provide companionship and support.

Someone from our friendly team of volunteers could:

- > Call in for a cup of tea and a chat
- > Accompany you on a local trip to a café, garden centre or similar
- > Help you with your shopping or prescription collection
- > Walk your dog occasionally whilst you are unwell or unable to get out
- > Provide you with subsidised transport to hospital for cancer-related appointments
- > Help with small practical tasks in the home



Which areas do we cover in the Southern Dales?

Our Connex Readycall team covers an area from Sudbury in the south and as far north as Hartington, including the towns of Ashbourne and Wirksworth. The map below gives an idea of the locations we can cover:
